**The Prosperity Gospel – January 30, 2012:** A look at tel-evangelism today and its emphasis on a vision of God as the One who gives me everything that I ask for if I truly envision it and believe it. In light of this approach, where does the cross fit into the picture?

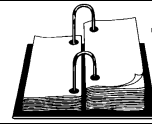
